ROUND ROBIN & HOT POTATO

It's Your Future, Don't Blow It! (Science)

Students use a **Round Robin** to list all aspects of modern life that could have a negative impact on the environment into the future, e.g. generating energy from fossil fuels, open-cut mining, carbon emissions from motor vehicles, over-grazing, land clearing, over-population and so on. Sort and transfer items from the Round Robin lists to A4 focus sheets under headings e.g. Individuals, Families, Community Groups, Local and City Councils, Regional Councils, State Governments and National Governments. Students then use a **Hot Potato** to list actions and responsibilities that individuals, groups and local, state and federal governments should undertake to solve the problems before they are irreversible.

Value Add: Using a **Problem-Solution** strategy (p.74), students then work out ways to solve some of these problems now.
